Tiny Rider is walking ONLY assisted or unassisted; on or off lead

Novice is 1st/2nd year showing in that discipline

Youth is <18 year as of January 1st 2024

Entries close two classes ahead & check in with paddock master before classes

HRR & Property Owners are not responsible for accidents or loss of property.
